School won't graduate Harvard-bound student

Stuart Shieber, a senior at University City High School who failed to graduate this year, has been accepted by Harvard, Yale, Princeton, and MIT, according to school officials.

Shieber, who had a 3.9 academic average and is described by University City High School Principal Earl C. Beeks as an "outstanding scholar," did not graduate with his class Thursday because he was one physical education credit short.

Last fall the youth appealed to the University City Board of Education to have the requirement waived. But the board held firm, according to school communications coordinator Mrs. Jane Popham.

Shieber's first choice, Harvard, accepted Shieber knowing he would not graduate from high school, according to a member of Shieber's family.
